Monitor Facilities Management was formed in March 1998 as a limited company, owned jointly by Monmouthshire County Council and Torfaen County Borough Council. The company acts as a service provider to Local Government, offering total facilities management for both hard and soft functions. Monitor currently operates from one main site, covering 17.5 acres, with 29,000 square metres of office and conference facilities. The company also operates certain functions on remote sites, set apart from the main campus, and therefore there is an additional requirement for remote security management.

The requirement for CCTV, access control and time management systems were to enhance security for both staff and premises, and to discourage theft. The G4S Technology Symmetry™ and Plantime systems have now improved the working conditions of staff, enhanced safety and increased the awareness of security.

The Symmetry system incorporates various integrated technologies via a PC platform, using the Microsoft Windows style guide. The comprehensive security system includes an external CCTV network to oversee all activity on the premises, and external traffic barriers to govern entry into, and out of the site. The barriers are operated via a personalised ID swipe card issued to all staff members (and potentially to site visitors in future via additional G4S Technology security installations).

The internal security system comprises a network of internal turnstiles, secure doors and CCTV cameras. These can be programmed to action automatic visual alerts at the Monitor security desk whenever an access point is forced, or if an unauthorised card is presented to a card reader anywhere on site; either on the immediate premises or on one of the remote sites.

"We have been extending existing systems and interfacing new technology and have been happy to work closely with G4S Technology to develop the total infrastructure," said Monitor Director, Garth Brookfield. Symmetry is a scalable enterprise system capable of coping with unlimited cardholders and configurations. It is an intuitive, user-friendly software package, simple to maintain, operate and upgrade as necessary. G4S Technology's Plantime system is a powerful management tool, which enables the effective recording of staff attendance; including overtime, annual leave and absenteeism. Both systems utilise the Microsoft© SQL format, thus enabling the simple import and export of data to other software packages. The two systems utilise simple graphic command icons such as those illustrated below.

Symmetry offers the following features and benefits:

- Centrally controlled software - providing a user-friendly interface from which to create/amend security profiles quickly and efficiently;
- Instantaneous CCTV coverage triggered by unauthorised access - ensuring events may be responded to as they occur, in 'real' time;
- Door alarms and 'event to action' alarms utilise dynamic on-screen mapping - ensuring that suitable manpower may be deployed swiftly and directly to the alarm activation point;

- Implementation of lost, stolen or unauthorised cards immediately identifiable -enabling action to be taken to recover the card and avoid further security breaches.

The Symmetry system at Monitor is currently in operation at the two main civic offices on the premises, with the Plantime system directly responsible for 1,600 staff members. The G4S Technology systems have been in place for many years now, having been inherited by Monitor from Gwent County Council.
